IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: The WARNING instructions issued in this manual are not meant to cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur. It must be understood that common sense, caution and carefulness are factors that cannot be built into all fans. The person(s) installing, maintaining, or operating, the fan must apply these factors. Failure to install, maintain, and/or operate the equipment according to the manufacturer's instructions may result in conditions which can produce bodily injury and/or property damage. Contact your dealer, service agent or the manufacturer about any problems or conditions you do not fully understand.

FOR YOUR SAFETY – To reduce the risk of fire or explosion, do not store or use gasoline or other flammable vapors or liquids in the vicinity of this fan.

ELECTRICAL SERVICE INFORMATION – To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock or personal injury, all wiring and grounding must conform to the latest edition of Local and National Electrical Codes. It is the customer's responsibility to have the wiring and fuses checked by a qualified electrician to make sure adequate electrical power is available.

GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS – Improper connection of the equipment-grounding conductor can result in a risk of electrical shock. Check with a qualified electrician or servicemen if you are in doubt as to whether your appliance outlets are properly grounded.

This fan must be grounded. In the event of a malfunction or breakdown, grounding will reduce the risk of electrical shock by providing a path of least resistance for electrical current. This fan is equipped with a cord having an equipment-grounding conductor and 3 prong grounding plug. The plug must be connected into an outlet that is properly installed and grounded in the accordance with all local codes and ordinances.

Do not modify the plug provided with the fan. If it does not fit the outlet, have a proper outlet installed by a qualified electrician.

If the household electrical supply does not meet specifications, or if you are not sure your home has an effective ground, have a qualified electrician or your local electrical utility company check it and correct any problems.

In addition,

- Close supervision is necessary when the fan is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use, when moving fan from one location to another, before putting on or taking off parts, cleaning.
- Avoid contacting moving parts.
- Do not operate with a damaged cord or plug or after the fan malfunctions, or has been dropped or

damaged in any manner.

- Do not let the cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- To disconnect, grip plug and pull from wall outlet. Never yank on cord.
- Always place the fan on a dry flat surface.
- This product is intended for household use ONLY and not for commercial or industrial use.



If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or its Service agent or similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.

OPERATIONS

Fan Speed

Move the Speed Level to either 1, 2, or 3 for Low, Medium or High fan speed. Move Speed Level to 0 to turn off the power.

Louver Switch

Turn the Louver Switch on or off to control the movement of the Louver.

Timer

Turn the Timer Knob clockwise, the "On", "Off", "20", "40", "60", "80", "100" and "120" will appear. When the Timer is on the "On" position, the fan will operate constantly. When the Timer is on "Off" position, the fan will stop. Turn the timer to the desired number for the number of minutes of continuous operation before the fan will shut off automatically.

Wall Mount

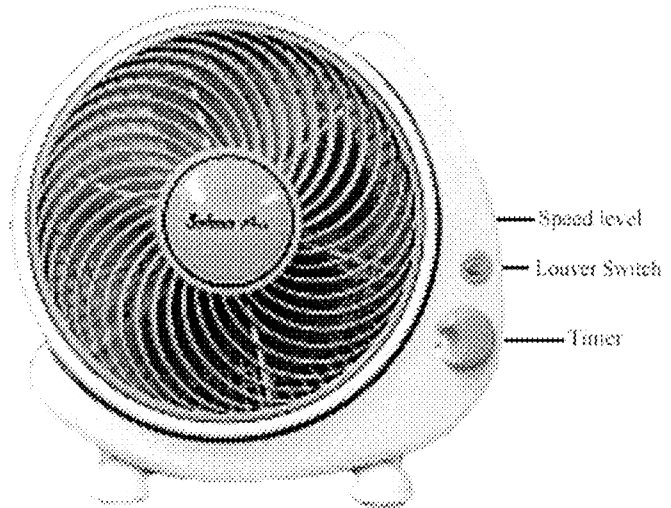
The fan can be mounted on the wall to cover a broader area. Affix two screws vertically on a wall 7 5/6" apart. Hand the fan over the screws before plug the power cord.

CARE, CLEANING AND STORAGE

- The body and grill should be cleaned regularly for most efficient operation with a damp cloth. Air dry completely before use.



Never immerse any fan component in Water, Wipe the fan only with a dry or slightly moist cloth, then immediately towel dry.



- Always store the fan in a cool and dry place.
